FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is Central Sports Soccer?

Central Sports Soccer is a Christ-centered soccer league where we strive for fun, growth, and respect. We want players to have fun while playing, grow as a player throughout the year, and play to win, but not at all costs. We also want the kids to have fun while learning about Jesus in devotionals during practice and before each game, grow in their faith and knowledge of Jesus, and respect the opponent as Jesus teaches us to love others.

When and where is Meet the Team?

Thursday, March 7th on the Soccer Fields

Kindergarten and below 6:00 pm

1st– 3rd Grade division – 6:30 pm

4th – 6th Grade division – 7:00 pm

When does practice start?

Week of March 25th

When are practices?

Practices are only once per week. Your team will practice on the same field, at the same time, on the same night every week. Times are either 5:30 or 6:30 pm on Monday, Tuesday or Thursday.

When is the first game and last game?

First Game – April 6th

Last Game – May 25th

Can I request a certain coach?

Unfortunately, due to the number of kids playing, we cannot honor coach requests.

When will I know what team, coach, and night of practice my child has?

Our coach trainings are February 29th and March 4th. Coaches will receive their roster one of those nights and should contact you before Meet the Team.

What if I don't hear from my coach before Meet the Team?

You can contact the office and we will let you know or you can find them at Meet the Team.

What if I can't make meet the team, a practice, or a game?

It is okay, just let your coach know.

If I have multiple kids playing, will they be on the same team or same night of practice?

If the children are in the same age division and are the same gender, they will be on the same team. We do everything possible to put siblings on the same night for practice.

Are shin guards required?

Yes, you cannot practice or play without them. We do not provide shin guards.

Are cleats required?

No, but cleats are recommended.

What size ball do they use?

Kindergarten and below – size 3

1st– 3rd Grade – size 4

4th – 6th Grade – size 5

What do the players receive?

A jersey, shorts, socks, a Bible, a medal, and a soccer ball.

I was not able to request someone to carpool with when I signed up, what do I do?

Due to the large number of participants, we can no longer guarantee carpool requests.
