

Position Summary

The Salt Company Director is the key leader responsible for directing the church's collegiate ministry and its efforts to reach one of the of the largest and most unique collegiate mission fields in the world. This position leads a team to engage 80,000+ students through a comprehensive ministry designed to reach the lost, equip students, and deploy disciples within the life of the local church. This Ministry Staff position reports to the Senior Director for Missions and Operations.

Position Emphases

- **Vision.** Champions and fosters alignment with the church's mission to make disciples who make a difference with the gospel and its vision to be a church where every generation is reaching the next generation—intentional about the campus as a strategic mission field.

- **Excellence.** Leads Salt Company efforts to deliver compelling and gospel-rich midweek gatherings as well as thoughtful and effective discipleship and evangelistic environments. Particularly committed to excellence and faithfulness in teaching as the Salt Company's primary teacher.
- **Development.** Drives efforts to identify and develop student leaders who help lead much of the work of the Salt Company's ministry, discipling them with an eye toward deploying them.
- **Integration.** Champions the church's discipleship pathway and actively integrates students within the life of the church's gathered worship, service, and discipleship spaces.
- **Engagement.** Develops and maintains relationships with students, campus leaders, university officials, and community partners to maximize reach of the Salt Company, all the while
- **Financial.** Works to oversee and manage fundraising for Salt Company efforts in general, to create pipelines of support from alumni, and to oversee Salt Company staff as they raise individual support.
- **Support.** Contributes oversight, guidance, and assistance to regular and special projects and strategic initiatives as needed, along with any other duties assigned.
